<b>Duration of Exchange</b>	<p>One semester or one academic year  <i>**For students of <u>Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau</u> nationality, we only accept 1-semester exchange due to visa issue. Students of <u>Mainland China</u> nationality can only apply for <u>single entry visa</u>.</i>  <i>**NCCU also accepts Japanese/ Korean students to go for one year exchange starting from spring semester to follow the Japanese/ Korean semester term, though there is still some time difference, for example the Japanese/ Korean Spring semester starts from April 1st while Taiwan one starts from February 1st.</i></p>	
<b>Required Level of Language Proficiency</b>	<p>Intensive Mandarin language courses are open to students of all levels, including those with no knowledge of Mandarin.  <b>**Chinese Language Proficiency:</b>            Students who want to take academic classes taught in Chinese are advised to demonstrate Chinese proficiency at least equivalent to TOCFL Superior / HSK Level 4.  <b>**English Language Proficiency:</b>            Students who wish to take academic classes taught in English are advised to have English proficiency at least equivalent to TOEFL iBT 80 / IELTS 6.0 / TOEIC 700/ CEFR B2.</p>

Mandarin Language Courses	<p><u>Intensive Mandarin Module</u>: OIC will operate 12 credits Intensive Mandarin course free of charge to exchange students.</p> <p><u>Part-time Mandarin Module</u>: OIC will operate 3 credits Part-time Mandarin course free of charge to exchange students.</p> <p>It is up to the student's home university whether the credits could be transferred.</p> <p>Students of <b>Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan</b> nationality will not be able to choose any Mandarin language courses. However, they can take other Mandarin-taught /English-taught academic courses at NCCU.</p>

<b>Insurance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Apply to all exchange students:</b> Students' Safety Insurance fee of <b>NT\$198 per semester</b> (Required)(The fee varies annually, but is usually bellow NT\$250)</li> <li>● <b>Apply to 1-semester exchange students only:</b> Purchase overseas medical insurance in home country to cover the entire stay in Taiwan. The fee varies in different countries.</li> <li>● <b>Apply to 1-year exchange students with ARC (Alien Resident Certificate):</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Purchase Overseas Medical Insurance in home country before departure for at least the first 6 months in Taiwan (Sep.-Feb. or Feb.-July). The fee varies in different countries.</li> <li>2. Required to join the <a href="#">National Health Insurance</a> after 6 months of <u>continuous residence</u> in Taiwan; insurance fee: <b>NT\$749/month</b></li> </ol> </li> </ul>
<b>Food</b>	NT\$10,000/ month (estimated)

Basic Procedure for Exchange Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <u>Exchange for 1 semester:</u> Visitor Visa→ Visitor Visa Extension (maximum extension 2 times)</li> <li>● <u>Exchange for 1 year:</u> Resident Visa (within 15 days after arrival)→ Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) →Join <a href="#">National Health Insurance</a> after a continuous residence in Taiwan for 6 months.</li> </ul>
Mainland China Nationality Entry Permit	NCCU will apply the entry permit on-line for nominated exchange students with Mainland China nationality. Thus, the admission letter and visa is different from other students.
