Insurance	 Apply to all exchange students: Students' Safety Insurance fee of NT\$121 per semester (Required) Apply to 1-semester exchange students: Buy overseas medical insurance in home country to cover the entire stay in Taiwan. The fee varies in different countries. Apply to 1-year exchange students with ARC (Alien Resident Certificate): Buy Overseas Medical Insurance in home country before departure for the first 6 months in Taiwan (SeptFeb. or FebJuly). The fee varies in different countries. Required to join the National Health Insurance after 6 months of continuous residence in Taiwan; insurance fee: NT\$749/month 	
Food	NT\$10,000/ month (estimated)	
Public Transport	NT\$3,000/ month (estimated)	
Textbooks	NT\$5,000~NT\$8,000/ semester (estimated) depends on how many classes students take	
Accommodation	Depends on what type of accommodation you choose. It's less expensive for on-campus dormitory, which charges by semester (details refer to V. Accommodation Section). Off-campus housing fees range from NT\$10,000-20,000 per month.
